
This is your Battery Bag for Airline Travel.

You must carry your Zinger battery on the plane with you and it is a good idea to close it in this bag before going through security. Always tell the baggage screener that your are carrying a Lithium Ion battery for a mobility device. The standard Zinger battery is 240 Watt Hours which is legal on airlines (our long range battery is not). *Read page 27 of your User Manual before airline travel.*

The two 14" ZipTies can be used to secure your Zinger in the folded position and restrain the caster wheels against the frame before checking it on an airplane. ZipTie both sides.

- 1. Send pointed end behind black frame part and silver frame tube below it.
- 2. Wrap pointed end around one wheel spoke.
- 3. Send pointed end through block end and pull tight (arrow)
